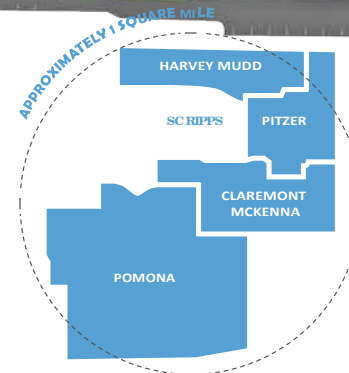

Getting to Claremont...

From the I-210 East:

- Exit Towne Avenue (Exit 50).
- Turn right onto Towne, traveling south until reaching Foothill Boulevard.
- Turn left onto Foothill. Travel east on Foothill to N College Ave.
- Turn right at the traffic light onto N Dartmouth Ave and proceed approximately two blocks to E 11th Street.
- Turn left onto 11th Street to enter the parking lot in front of the building.

From I-10 headed East:

- Exit Indian Hill Boulevard (Exit 47).
- Turn left off the freeway onto Indian Hill Blvd and drive north to Arrow Hwy.
- Turn right onto Arrow Hwy Street. Continue for less than a quarter mile to S College Ave.
- Turn left onto S College Ave and continue for about a mile until E 11th St. Please note that S College Ave will turn into N College Ave.
- Turn right onto E 11th Street proceed to the next block and drive past Dartmouth Ave to enter the parking lot in front of the building.

From I-210 West:

- Exit Baseline Avenue (Exit 52).
- Turn right onto Baseline Ave.
- Turn left onto N Mills Ave.
- Turn right onto E Foothill Blvd/Historic Rte 66 W.
- Turn left onto N Dartmouth Ave and proceed approximately two blocks to E 11th Street.
- Turn left onto 11th Street to enter the parking lot in front of the building.

From I-10 headed West:

- Exit Indian Hill Boulevard (Exit 47).
- Turn right off the freeway onto Indian Hill Blvd and drive north a little over half a mile to Arrow Hwy.
- Turn right onto Arrow Hwy and continue for less than a quarter of a mile to S College Ave.
- Turn left onto S College Ave and continue for about a mile until E 11th St. Please note that S College Ave will turn into N College Ave.
- Turn right onto E 11th Street proceed to the next block and drive past Dartmouth Ave to enter the parking lot in front of the building.
